Striving to be ON TRACK

Beginning this school year the Ohio Department of Education made it mandatory for all Grade 3 students in both public and private schools to pass reading in order to be promoted to Grade 4. The Ohio Reading Guarantee is a new way in which the state of Ohio identifies students who are behind in reading in kindergarten through Grade 3. Teachers have been diligently assessing students with an approved reading diagnostic assessment to determine their

ON TRACK/NOT ON

TRACK status. ON TRACK means that the student is on track to earn a promotion score on the state's English Language Arts grade 3 reading test (taken in December) or on track to earn a promotion score on the IOWA Reading Form F grade 3 test (taken on November 17). K -3 students determined to be NOT ON TRACK must begin receiving intensive reading instruction; parents/guardians will be notified in writing of their

child's reading status.

It is vital that
EdChoice students take
these test. If not, scholarships may be taken away.
The test scores will be evaluated and used to monitor
students yearly progress.



St. Benedict the Moor Catholic School is providing help and support to make sure students are ON TRACK in reading. Church volunteers from St. Benedict the Moor Catholic Church and students from the University of Dayton provide free tutoring for students.

Grade 3 students will also

have other opportunities to pass the Ohio Reading Guarantee assessments in 2016; therefore, please do not be discouraged if student is NOT ON TRACK for with prayer and determination all will meet the ultimate goal to be ON TRACK and be a successful reader.
