
Black History Concert Celebration on February 29

lowa Tests meet Ohio's standardized test requirements and offer educators a diagnostic look at how their students are progressing in key academic areas. This test will be available for Kindergarten to Grade 3 from March1-March 23.

The Ohio State Test for Grade 3 will include English Language Arts tests and Mathematics. They will take the test from April 4 to April 22.

Next year St. Benedict the Moor will add Grade 4 to the student enrollment. Registration is happening now. If you register before March 11. 2016 the fee would be \$50.00 for 1 child and \$75.00 for 2 or more. If you register after March 11 the fee will increase by \$25.00. So SAVE and register today!
