Grade 3 Reading Proficiency Will Have

More Ways to Pass in 2016-2017

On January 12, 2016 the state issued the approved list of alternative assessments for third grade reading that districts may use in 2016-2017. These alternative reading assessments are optional for districts to administer to third grade students for the purpose of determining whether they have demonstrated acceptable levels of reading performance for promotion to the fourth grade. The Renaissance Learning STAR Reading Third Grade Reading Proficiency Assessment is a new option on the list of acceptable assessments. St. Benedict the Moor has been using Renaissance for over a year, and this program will continue to help students improve reading scores.
