School Spirit Starting Strong

Welcome to the **first edition of "The Rising Star Newsletter**." St. Benedict the Moor Catholic School's monthly newsletter. Although the publication is a month late highlighting August events will enhance the school's spirit.

In the first week of school for staff /teachers there was a special open house held in the morning of August 11. Last minute details for beautification of the school was still in progress. Students from Duquesne University in Pittsburg, PA., area students from the Dayton Job Center, and parishioner Ed McDonald from St. Benedict the Moor Church painted the interior of the school and the multi-purpose room.
