
Weather Conditions

Returning Student Registration Fee

Early Bird registration for the 2019-2020 school year will be \$40 per student and \$65 per family starting Monday, January 28, 2019 thru Friday, February 1, 2019. After February 4 registration fee will increase to \$50 per student and \$75 per

family (Non-Refundable).
