## Quarter 3 Begins with Hybrid Classes

Mark your calendars, starting on Tuesday, January 19, 2021 thru March 19, 2021 St. Benedict the Moor will be offering two instruction plans (Model A and Model B). Model A will consist of an in-person/in-building learning model. **Model B** will continue remote learning. Both models offer a four day in-school work plan [Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday] with Wednesday students on remote learning. The start/dismissal time will be 7:15 am. - 2:30 pm.

Covid-19 is still a pandemic. The school will follow all preventive measures set forth by the Montgomery County Health Department and Ohio State government to the highest degree possible to ensure the safety of all students and staff.

When students/staff return to in-person classes their temperatures cannot be 100 degrees or higher. Students/ staff must wear a face mask or face shield that covers both nose and mouth. Provide your child with a water bottle because water fountains will not be available for use. Every Wednesday the school will undergo thorough cleaning and sanitation. Proper handwashing will be necessary.

Keep in mind that students must come to the school in order to take mandatory testing. The Ohio State Science Test (Grades 5 and 8)[March 22-April 23], the OELPA test (for some K-8 students)[February 1-March 26], IOWA/CogAT test (Grades 2-8)[February 22-March 16], and NCEA-ACRE for grades 5 and 8 [January 18-February 5] are mandatory test that are not allowed to be taken outside of school.
