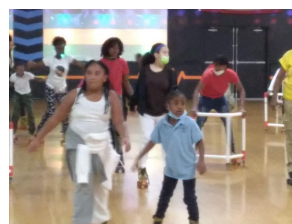
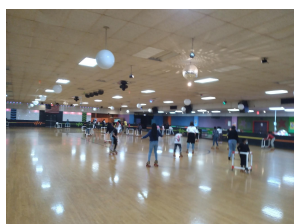

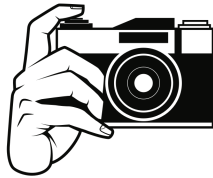
Skating Fun Day with Stay on Track Students
