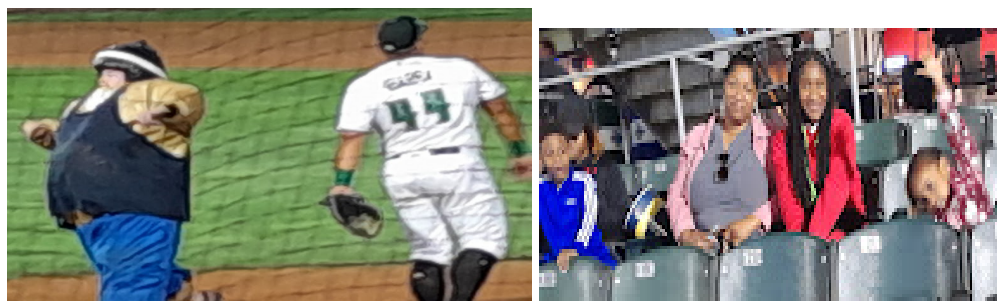

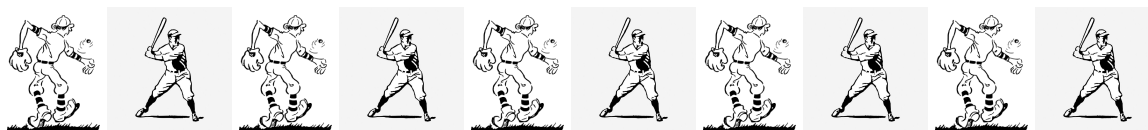
The Layne & Brown families posing with mascot--3 Fort Wayne Tincaps pitchers **pitched a no hitter** with Dayton Dragons losing 6-0

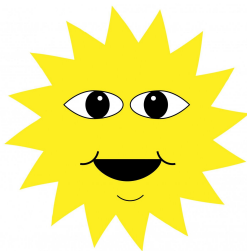
