Students Focus on Testing

In the beginning of St. Benedict the Moor school year it was decided by the Archdiocese of Cincinnati and Principal Debra Johnson that students take i-Ready assessments and Ohio State testing. Since the majority of our students receive academic scholarships or EdChoice awards the tests are a requirement.

Replacing the 'No Child Left Behind Act', the 'Every Student Succeeds Act' or ESSA is the main education law for public schools in America. In Ohio, students in grades 3 through grade 8 take the Ohio State Test (OST) in English language arts and math. The ELA testing completion is April 29, 2024, math completion is May 10, and Science for grades 5 and 8 is also May 10th. Gradually, standardized tests have been improving at St. Benedict the Moor. Most state tests are not pass/fail, but are rather used for identifying students who need extra help in reading and in math. Students are encouraged to do their best.


Students Crown Mother Mary


