


Recently, the students at St. Benedict the Moor was introduced to another learning diagnostic, which is called **i-Ready.** Many public and private schools nationwide have been using this program. **i-Ready Diagnostic** is a type of computer online test that matches the difficulty level for kindergartners through grade 12 students. As students answer questions correctly, they will get more difficult questions. When students make mistakes, they will get easier questions. The **i-Ready Diagnostic** is supposed to help each student in the best possible way.

Soon after the holiday break our school began the first **i-Ready Diagnostic** in Reading and in Math. This diagnostic must be completed by January 26th in order to receive an accurate report for the next **i-Ready Diagnostic** in February. ²As students answer questions correctly or incorrectly, the test adjusts up or down, with questions of varying difficulty, until the **i-Ready Diagnostic** reaches the level of difficulty that is right for each student. Summing up, each student will see a test made just for them. Questions are intended to be challenging in order to help the student grow and to learn. Students are encouraged to try and to do their best.
